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

Note: The system will perform all computations and enter them on the Summary Pages that are available before an LEA transmits the final version of the Form. Respondents will be asked to complete the entire Title I Supplement process and then will have the opportunity to review the Summary Pages (there are tabs at the top to examine the LEA Information Form, the Building Information Form(s), and the K-12 Administration Option Form). There is an opportunity to make correction to the Form(s) at the time just before final submittal. However, the data must be submitted after any entry is changed before the change can be recorded on the file. By entering the Fiscal Year, LEA and an E-Mail Contact Address on the first page, one can retrieve the last submission which will bring you to a summary page you can then make corrections to the Form by clicking on the **update icon** next to Update the LEA information for 2015-2016. In addition, many of the fields are either pre-populated with a default response (note: review the default selection before passing over a particular item), or computed by the system. Feel free to do the math beforehand, and, for those LEAs not utilizing the K-12 Administrative Option, to use the [worksheet](#) . (41KB)
